E-NEWSLETTER OF MAHESHTALA MUNICIPALITY FOR THE MONTH OF JANUARY, 2020

Activities during the month of December 2019

Activities under Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana-National Urban Livelihoods Mission: WBSULM (West Bengal State Urban Livelihood Mission):

- State Self-Help Group and Self-Employment Department (SHG and SE) organizes *Sabala Mela* every year for the Self Help Groups and entrepreneurs. This year at the sub divisional level, Sabala Mela was organized under Budge Budge I Block during 7-13 December 2019. Seven Self Help Groups of Maheshtala Municipality participated in the *Mela* with different products and food items and got high response.



- Six Self Help Groups (SHG) were formed and got their group savings bank account opened in the month of December.
- Fifteen SHGs who have completed at least three months, maintaining *Pancha Sutra* and received capacity building trainings received one time revolving fund of Rupees ten thousand.
- Capacity building training was organized for 40 SHGs, these trainings would help the members to develop understanding about the scheme and its benefits and how to maintain all the books of the group as well.



- As per government guideline if a SHG completes at least 6 months, follows *Pancha Sutra* and scores a minimum of 70% then they are eligible to get Cash Credit Loans. 17 SHGs received Cash Credit loans in this month
- Christmas was celebrated in the Shelter for Urban Homeless, and this helped the inmates to live a day differently and break the monotony. Monthly health check up camp was conducted for the inmates of the Shelter for Urban Homeless and free medicines were given as per requirement.



Activities under National Urban Health Mission:

- The *Intensified Mission Indradhanush* (IMI) 2.0 has been launched across India on December 2, 2019. The mission aims to immunize children less than 2 years of age and pregnant women against eight vaccine-preventable diseases. The immunisation drive covers vaccines for tuberculosis, meningitis, measles, Hepatitis B, tetanus, whooping



cough, poliomyelitis and diphtheria. The vaccines for two other diseases- Hemophilus influenza and Japanese encephalitis are also being provided under the scheme in certain selected areas.

In Maheshtala Municipality area the programme was launched on 2nd of December. 18 high risk wards were selected to implement the mission. 877 children 42 pregnant women were vaccinated in this month.

Seven Special Outreach Health Camps were organized under NUHM, to address the basic health care needs of the marginalized community. 354 people received free medical consultation and medicines.

- In this month 1523 new families received Swasthya Sathi card for basic health cover for secondary and tertiary care up to Rs. 5 lakh per annum per family. It is a medical insurance entirely sponsored by Government of West Bengal.



- Fogging, spraying of mosquito repellents, cleaning of garbage, drains are taken up on regular basis to control vector borne disease.

Activities under Green City Mission:

Government of West Bengal has launched Green City Mission to combat the challenges of rapid urbanisation. State Government wants to build environment friendly, sustainable, liveable, energy positive, IT friendly and safe city. While emphasising on building eco friendly and sustainable city, State Government also wants to give focus on creation of jobs and building affordable housing for poor.

- Under this mission Maheshtala Municipality has developed 13 parks, 12 parks are fully operational and 1 is under construction. The remaining one is expected to be completed soon.
- Beautification works of five Ghats on the banks to river Ganges have been undertaken under this mission. Work of two ghats have been completed and opened for use of the public.
- Eleven public toilets constructed throughout the municipal area, and those are functional now. Public toilets were constructed in crowded areas like market places; bus stands hospitals etc. so that many passersby can access to these toilets.
- 40 passenger shades were built and all of those are functional. These shades were constructed mainly on major bus routes



Activities under Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT):

- 8 public parks constructed under AMRUT which are fully operational. Another park is under construction and to be completed shortly.



- Another important component under this mission is construction of underground sewerage system. The work is in progress and is being supervised by KMDA.
