Activities during the month of January 2019

1. Activities under Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana-National Urban Livelihoods Mission: WBSULM (West Bengal State Urban Livelihood Mission):

- Revolving Fund of Rs 10,000 was given to five Self Help Groups after first internal grading. Five SHGs received cash credit loans of 1.5 lakh each from the respective bank branches. This loan amount helps the SHG members initiate micro business and those who are already involved in some kind of income generating activities stand benefitted from the loan. Seven SHGs were graded in this month and proposal forwarded to the bank for Cash Credit loans.



- One Capacity Building training was organized comprising five SHGs of Ward no 20. Through the training basic orientation

was given to the SHG members on the Urban Livelihood Mission, such as, what are the privileges a SHG member can get and also their responsibility. 33 SHG members attended the training.



- Several SHGs are working excellently as Mahila Arogya Samiti and putting their all effort to improve the surrounding environment. To raise awareness they are taking up small rallies, putting posters and cleaning neighborhood to reduce breeding of mosquito.



- In collaboration with the EnGIO (Environment Governed Integrated Organisation) an orientation of Mahila Arogya Samiti was organized where 108 SHG members from 108 SHGs participated. This orientation will help the MASSs to work more effectively in their locality. The EnGIO is a voluntary organization involved in capacity building activities of MAS with support from UNICEF.

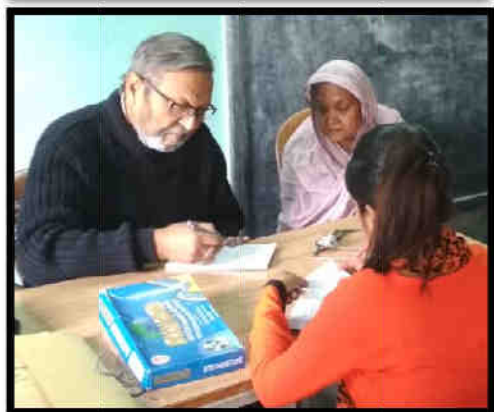


2. Activities under National Urban Health Mission:

Fourteen health outreach camps were organized in different remote places of the municipal areas where susceptible marginalized people reside. Through the camps free medicines are provided along with medical advices and check up. 629 people were served through the camps in January.
