Activities during the month of February 2020

Secondary examination of West Bengal Board started in this month. On the day of first examination, representatives of Maheshtala Municipality reached in front of eleven schools at different wards to wish them with good luck with a token gift. 3475 students received the said gifts and thanked Maheshtala Municipality for this splendid endeavour.



Activities under Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana - National Urban Livelihoods Mission: WBSULM (West Bengal State Urban Livelihood Mission):

- A financial literacy camp was organized on 26th of February in collaboration with Bangiya Gramin Vikash Bank – Santoshpur Branch. Manager of the branch was present in the programme to aware group members about different financial schemes of the government. She also enlightened members on the importance of financial management. Vice Chairman of Maheshtala Municipality was present in the programme.
- Two New Self Help Groups (SHG) got their group savings bank account and started following Pancha Sutra as per norms. Thirty three SHGs who were successfully graded for the first time, received one time revolving fund of



Rs. 10,000/-. Three Area Level Federations (ALF) were formed in this month in ward number 8, 14 and 34. Two ALFs of ward number 22 and 23 received revolving fund of Rs. 50,000/- each.

- Eight SHGs received Cash Credit Loans for the first time and two SHGs received Cash Credit Loans for the second time amounting Rs. 2.5 lakh each.
- As per instruction of State Urban Development Agency, an initiative has been taken in assistance Maheshtala College to ensure quality life for the inmates of Shelter of Urban Homeless. College students will visit the shelter once in a month and will take up different kinds of activities. Mr. Sudeep Sarkar and Mr Subhasis De, Assistant Professor of the college visited the SUH on 20th of February and interacted with the inmates present at that time. They suggested thatf every month a date can be fixed upon mutual agreement, when students will visit the shelter and take up some social activities as well. They also expressed that these activities may be linked with initiatives of NCC.



- Health check up camp for the inmates of the SUH was organized on 28th February.

8 Special Outreach Health Camps were organized this month to offer basic health services to the people of marginalized community.

- Training of Mahila Arogya Samiti has been initiated, from this month. 10 Self Help Groups who are also acting as Mahila Arogya Samiti received training to ensure health and hygiene in their respective area.
- Fogging, spraying of mosquito repellents, cleaning of garbage and drains are taken up on regular basis to control vector borne diseases.
