Activities during the month of September 2017

1. Activities under National Urban Health Mission (NUHM)

✓ Special Outreach Health Camps

Concentrating on ward no 4, two special outreach health camps were organized in the month of September at Makalhati and Gulzar bag. Through these camps 110 marginalized people were served with free health checkups, medicines and suggestion to maintain sound health



Special Outreach Health Camps

✓ Prevention of Dengue

This is the time when Dengue fever takes monstrous dimension and takes lives due to small ignorance. Prevention is the most important thing to remain safe from this menace. To raise awareness regular home visits are undertaken by the health workers. Roughly one lakh houses in this month have been visited to counsel people about dengue fever and how to prevent it from spreading.

Pulse Polio Drive

✓ Pulse Polio Programme

From 10th to 15th September Pulse Polio drive was undertaken to prevent children from being infected by polio virus. 42,398 children up to the age of 5 were immunized through Polio booth and door to door visits.

2. Activities under Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana-National Urban Livelihoods Mission: WBSULM (West Bengal Urban Livelihood Mission):

10 new savings bank accounts of Self Help Groups have been opened in this month through women of marginalised population to start micro savings and also be able to take micro loans easily. 22 SHG groups awarded with one time revolving fund amounting Rs. 10,000/- each which increases the amount in their group account and enable them to take loans. In this month 10 groups passed internal grading process and forwarded to the bank branches concerned for their Cash Credit loan. Six groups which were graded previously and sent to banks got their cash credit loan accounts. Each group received Rs. 1.25 lakh as loan amount.

- ✓ In ward number 3 and 10, two Area Level Federations (ALF) have been formed in this month. 75 SHG members were present in the orientation programme.
- ✓ Skill training programmes in seven different trades are going on at present. Around 270 students are attending these trainings through nine batches. It is expected after completion of the training courses trainees will be able to secure their future financially.
