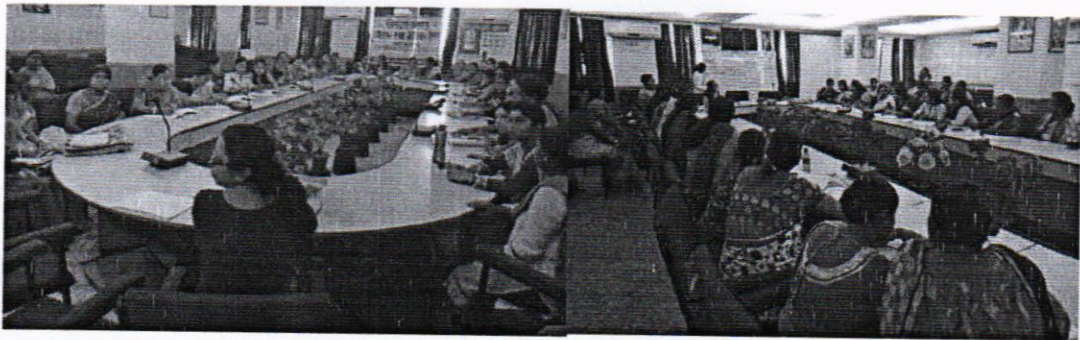

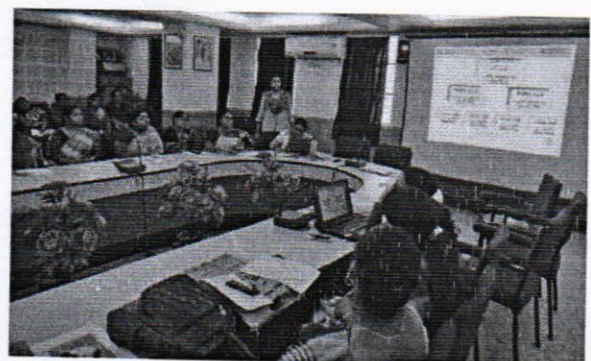
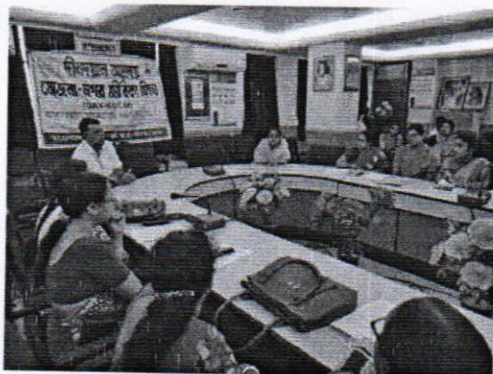
Activities during the month of November 2019

Activities under Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana-National Urban Livelihoods Mission: WBSULM (West Bengal State Urban Livelihood Mission):

- Four new Self Help Groups (SHG) are formed in this month and opened their group savings bank account. They have started maintaining all the books of accounts. 41 SHGs received Basic Orientation training and training on maintaining books of accounts. These kinds of training help the members to develop understanding about the scheme and its benefits and how to maintain all the books of the group as well.



Two Area Level Federations are formed in ward no 7 and 13. These federations will get registered under Society Registration Act shortly and will act as Social Organization to support and strengthen other SHGs of their wards.



- To increase number of Cash Credit loan disbursement of the SHGs two special grading weeks were observed in this month. 1st grading week was observed during 11th to 16th of November and the 2nd was 25th to 30th November. Total 46 SHGs were qualified to get cash credit loans and their applications were forwarded to the bank branches. Thirteen SHGs received cash credit (CC) loans of total Rs. Forty-five lakh, after successful grading of those groups.



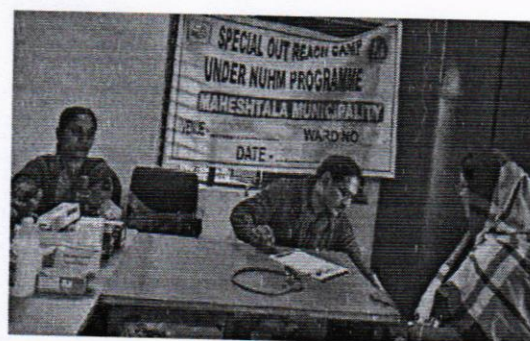
- A special Health Check up camp was organized for the inmates of the Shelter for Urban Homeless and free medicines were given as per requirement. Out of ten inmates eight attended the camp.

Activities under National Urban Health Mission:

- Seven Special Outreach Health Camps were organized to provide curative and preventive medical care through which 378 patients received free medical consultation and medicines. Special Health camp to address the need of the people during *Chhat Puja* was also organized. Details of the camps and services are given here -
